Minutes of the Meeting of the General Membership

Friday, January 8, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 2:23 pm.

The Agenda was accepted with no corrections.

Kim moved to accept the **minutes of the November 8, 2020 Board Meeting**. Herb seconded the motion and the motion unanimously passed.

Mickey Dufilho moved that the **officers of the Friends of Brazoria Wildlife Refuges for 2021** shall be Lisa Myers as President, Ed Barrios as Vice President, Marty Cornell as Secretary, and Regina Tippett as Treasurer. Herb Myers seconded the motion, which then passed with unanimous consent.

The board agreed that board meetings will continue to be held on the second Friday of the six oddnumbered months of the year.

Completed Action Items since the last board meeting are:

• Sherie Young has approved the transfer of excess money (\$1,173.22) in the Bryan Adams Memorial Fund to our general funds.

The active Action Register can be found at the end of this report.

Projects:

- The Bobcat Woods Trail has been completed and an inspection report has been sent by Marty to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. TPWD will shortly issue us the remaining \$8,000 in our grant.
- Repair of the boardwalks at Dow Woods will start on Monday.

Financial:

The financial statement for December 2020, is attached below. Future financial statements will reflect the two-month period between board meetings.

Dick is discussing a full audit by Curtis Craig, CPA; the estimated cost is \$10,000, which Kim believes to be a reasonable price.

The need for and frequency of official audits was discussed. Grantors sometimes request an audit report, but some do not, such as, per Mike Lange, the NRCS who is processing our recent grant application. Kim was asked to probe our fiduciary obligation in view of our rather substantial cash flow. Kim thought that an audit should be done every two years; Lisa expressed doubt that audits are needed that frequently. Our last full audit was done for the 2018 books. This issue was tabled for decision at the March board meeting.

Dick noted that our balance at Merrill Lynch exceeds over \$600,000, which is beyond the insured limit. He will investigate options for other investments that would insure all our funds.

The transition of the treasurer role from Dick to Regina will require a change of signature authority. At present, this authority is granted to Dick, Lisa, and Ed, but Ed wants to be removed from this obligation. Kim will investigate the possible requirement that only officers may be granted signature authority.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:30 PM.
